Special pedagogical approaches

"We believe that playful learning is one of the ways to recognize and connect both kids and grown-ups with different languages and backgrounds. Play can be the human language that transcends other spoken languages. We are also inspired by a new pedagogy called the "thinking classroom", where students get the chance to express their ways of understanding the subject. Students are given the opportunity to show knowledge like their mathematical skills in their home language and to succeed despite the fact that they don't have all the words in Danish yet."
